Tom Murphy

- Tom Murphy is a Senior Resident Fellow at the Urban Land Institute.
- Murphy served three terms as mayor of Pittsburgh from 1994 through 2005. During that time he initiated public-private partnership strategies for economic development; led efforts to secure two professional sports facilities and a convention center; developed partnerships to transform abandoned industrial properties into new commercial, residential, retail and public uses; and oversaw the development of more than 25 miles of new riverfront trails and urban green space.
- Prior to serving as mayor, Murphy served eight terms in the Pennsylvania State General Assembly House of Representatives and two years in the Peace Corps in Paraguay.
- He is a graduate of the New Mayors Program at Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government and holds a masters of science degree in urban studies from Hunter College and a bachelor of science degree in biology and chemistry from John Carroll University.
